Langkawi International Airport (LGK) is located in **Padang Matsirat**, approximately 25 km southwest of **Kuah Town**, Kedah, Malaysia. The airport features a modern single-terminal layout with check-in facilities, immigration, baggage claim, and duty-free shopping, providing a convenient gateway for domestic and international travelers.

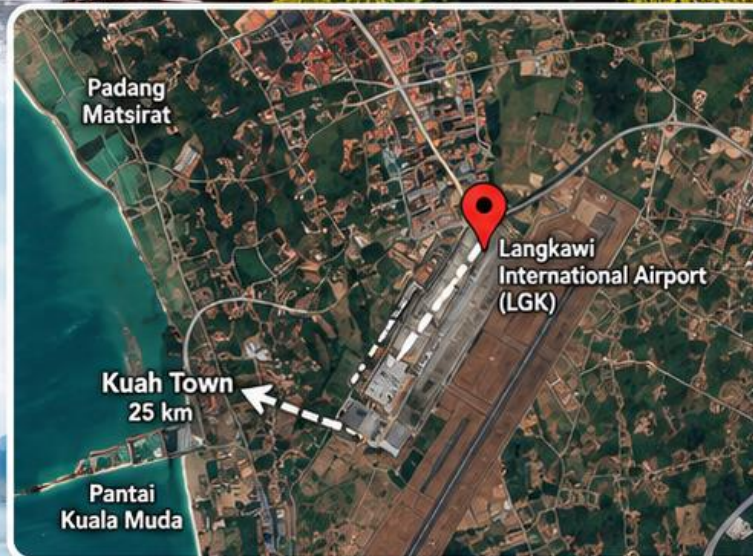

LANGKAWI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (LGK)

Langkawi International Airport (LGK) handles direct international flights from a handful of regional destinations, but most global travelers access the island via a quick domestic connection from major Malaysian hubs.



DIRECT INTERNATIONAL ROUTES

If you want to skip a transit within mainland Malaysia, you can book a direct international flight to Langkawi from Flight Connections:



Singapore (SIN):

Operated frequently by budget carriers Scoot and AirAsia.



Tashkent, Uzbekistan (TAS):

Long-haul direct service provided seasonally by Batik Air, taking roughly 7 hours and 45 minutes.



Medan, Indonesia (KNO):

Short regional hops connecting Sumatra to Langkawi.



CONNECTING VIA DOMESTIC GATEWAYS

Most international travelers fly into one of Malaysia's larger entry points and switch to a domestic flight. Check out the scheduling rules on Skyscanner Malaysia:



Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KUL):

The most popular transit route. Over 130 direct weekly flights run from KUL to LGK, taking about 1 hour and 5 minutes. Carriers include AirAsia, Malaysia Airlines, and Batik Air.



Penang International Airport (PEN):

Located just south of Langkawi, this offers a fast 35-to-40-minute hop via AirAsia or Firefly.



Johor Bahru (JHB):

Direct domestic links are also available from the southern tip of the peninsula.

TRANSIT TIP: When connecting through Kuala Lumpur (KUL), make sure you leave at least 2 to 3 hours to clear immigration, collect your luggage, and change from the international terminal (KLIA Terminal 1) to the low-cost terminal (KLIA Terminal 2) if swapping to a budget carrier.



VISA INFORMATION FOR MALAYSIA

Malaysia offers visa-free entry to citizens of many countries. However, travelers from certain nationalities must obtain a visa before arrival or apply through the Malaysia eVISA (MYVISA) system. Visa requirements vary depending on nationality and purpose of travel.

MALAYSIA eVISA APPLICATION PROCESS

- Check your visa eligibility.
- Apply online through the official MYVISA portal.
- Complete the application form.
- Upload the required documents.
- Pay the applicable visa fee.
- Receive your approved eVISA by email.
- Present your passport and eVISA upon arrival in Malaysia.

- Passport-size photograph
- Confirmed return or onward ticket
- Accommodation booking
- Proof of sufficient financial means (if requested)
- Supporting documents depending on nationality or visit purpose



IMPORTANT TRAVEL INFORMATION

- AIRPORT:** Langkawi International Airport (LGK)
- Complete the Malaysia Digital Arrival Card (MDAC) if required before arrival.
- Ensure your passport has at least 6 months' validity.
- Travelers transiting through Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KUL) should allow 2-3 hours for immigration, baggage collection, and terminal transfer where necessary.

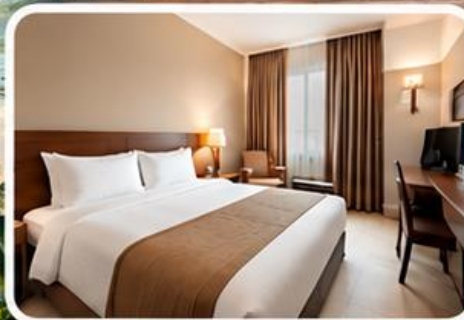
